

This posting provides important information if you are a midwife who received your midwifery education outside of Canada, and you want to know how you may be able to become registered (licensed) as a midwife in Manitoba.

In 2014 the College of Midwives of Manitoba (CMM) will provide an opportunity for internationally educated midwives (IEMs) to be assessed. The "2014 IEM Assessment Process" will take place in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The 2014 IEM Assessment Process is part of a Manitoba Health project that will provide midwifery assessment and midwifery gap training to help prepare internationally educated midwives apply for registration (licensure) as a midwife in Manitoba.

The application deadline for this assessment and gap training process is January 20, 2014.
