



This posting provides important information if you are a midwife who received your midwifery education outside of Canada, and you want to know how you may be able to become registered (licensed) as a midwife in Manitoba.

In 2014 the College of Midwives of Manitoba (CMM) will provide an opportunity for internationally educated midwives (IEMs) to be assessed. The “*2014 IEM Assessment Process*” will take place in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The *2014 IEM Assessment Process* is part of a Manitoba Health project that will provide midwifery assessment and midwifery gap training to help prepare internationally educated midwives apply for registration (licensure) as a midwife in Manitoba.

The application deadline for this assessment and gap training process is January 20, 2014.
